Executive Order

As per the letter no. *BMHC/Planning-MOH (07)/2019-20/4462* dated *January 21 2020*, it has been reported that the medical and health professionals who are authorised prescribers are not writing the prescription legibly. The legibility of prescription is vital to ensure that the patient knows what medicine(s) has or have been prescribed; the pharmacy does not make any errors while dispensing the medicine(s), and as well the identity of the prescriber to avoid the prescription from non-authorised officials.

Therefore, all the authorised prescribers as per the Medical and Health Council Regulation of Bhutan are hereby instructed to comply with the following, while prescribing:

- 1. All prescriptions should be legible;
- 2. The prescription should be signed with the name, BMHC registration number; and
- 3. Practice and prescribe within your respective scope.

This is being issued for strict compliance.
